Jetfly and its clients donate flights to transport frontline care professionals and medical equipment around Europe. Over 200 hours of flight time are available free of charge.

Leudelange, 20th of April 2020 - Jetfly operates one of the largest private aviation fleets in Europe and is committed to the fight against the Coronavirus by making part of its fleet of Pilatus PC-12 aircraft available free of charge to medical professionals in Europe.

As part of the a solidarity initiative launched by the association **Aviation Sans Frontières** in France, Jetfly called upon its client base to donate flight hours in order to save lives. After an extremely positive response, more than 200 flight hours have been collected.

In cooperation with the association Aviation Sans Frontières, the aim is to help those saving lives by getting them to where they are needed the most and in the safest and quickest way possible.

About fifteen flights have already been operated free of charge and many more are currently being prepared.
